

Present Simple

Affirmative	Interrogative	Negative
I <u>eat.</u>	<u>Do</u> I eat?	I <u>do not</u> eat.
You eat.	Do you eat?	You do not eat.
He/She/It <u>eats.</u>	<u>Does</u> he/she/it eat?	He/She/It <u>does</u> not eat.
We eat.	Do we eat?	We do not eat.
You eat.	Do you eat?	You do not eat.
They eat.	Do they eat?	They do not eat.

Present Simple Continuous

Affirmative	Interrogative	Negative
I <u>am eating.</u>	<u>Am I</u> eating?	I <u>am not</u> eating.
You are eating.	Are you eating?	You are not eating.
He/She/It is eating.	Is he/she/it eating?	He/She/It is not eating.
We are eating.	Are we eating?	We are not eating.
You are eating.	Are you eating?	You are not eating.
They are eating.	Are they eating?	They are not eating.

Past Simple

Affirmative	Interrogative	Negative
I <u>ate.</u>	<u>Did</u> I eat?	I <u>did</u> not eat.
You ate.	Did you eat?	You did not eat.
He/She/It ate.	Did he/she/it eat?	He/She/It did not eat.
We ate.	Did we eat?	We did not eat.
You ate.	Did you eat?	You did not eat.
They ate.	Did they eat?	They did not eat.

Future Simple

Affirmative	Interrogative	Negative
I <u>will</u> eat.	<u>Will I</u> eat?	<u>I will not</u> eat.
You will eat.	Will you eat?	You will not eat.
He/She/It will eat.	Will he/she/it eat?	He/She/It will not eat.
We will eat.	Will we eat?	We will not eat.
You will eat.	Will you eat?	You will not eat.
They will eat.	Will they eat?	They will not eat.

Present Perfect

Affirmative	Interrogative	Negative
I <u>have</u> eaten.	<u>Have I</u> eaten?	<u>I have not</u> eaten.
You have eaten.	Have you eaten?	You have not eaten.
He/She/It has eaten.	Has he/she/it eaten?	He/She/It has not eaten.
We have eaten.	Have we eaten?	We have not eaten.
You have eaten.	Have you eaten?	You have not eaten.
They have eaten.	Have they eaten?	They have not eaten.

Past Continuous

Affirmative

I was eating.

You were eating.

He/She/It was eating.

We were eating.

You were eating.

They were eating.

Interrogative

Was I eating?

Were you eating?

Was he/she/it eating?

Were we eating?

Were you eating?

Were they eating?

Negative

I was not eating.

You were not eating.

He/She/It was not eating.

We were not eating.

You were not eating.

They were not eating.

Past Perfect

Affirmative

I had eaten.

You had eaten.

He/She/It had eaten.

We had eaten.

You had eaten.

They had eaten.

Interrogative

Had I eaten?

Had you eaten?

Had he/she/it eaten?

Had we eaten?

Had you eaten?

Had they eaten?

Negative

I had not eaten.

You had not eaten.

He/She/It had not eaten.

We had not eaten.

You had not eaten.

They had not eaten.

Future Perfect

Affirmative

I will have eaten.

You will have eaten.

He/She/It will have eaten.

We will have eaten.

You will have eaten.

They will have eaten.

Interrogative

Will I have eaten?

Will you have eaten?

Will he/she/it have eaten?

Will we have eaten?

Will you have eaten?

Will they have eaten?

Negative

I will not have eaten.

You will not have eaten.

He/She/It will not have eaten.

We will not have eaten.

You will not have eaten.

They will not have eaten.

Conditional

Affirmative

I would eat.

You would eat.

He/She/It would eat.

We would eat.

You would eat.

They would eat.

Interrogative

Would I eat?

Would you eat?

Would he/she/it eat?

Would we eat?

Would you eat?

Would they eat?

Negative

I would not eat.

You would not eat.

He/She/It would not eat.

We would not eat.

You would not eat.

They would not eat.
